Answer the following prompt: Just like we all need someone to teach us how to drive, sometimes we need other people to teach us how to be the best versions of ourselves. In 600 words or less describe someone who has been a positive influence on your life and how they have inspired you.

The applicant must submit a one-page statement (double-spaced, if typed) stating educational intent and financial need.

Essay, 1,000-word maximum: (apply to your own future career goals)

What inspired you to want to help protect the rights of injury victims?

What have you done thus far that has helped to protect the rights of injury victims?

In what ways will your education help you to achieve your goals of wanting to help improve the lives of people who have suffered from a personal injury?

A typed essay of 300-500 words about a time when you faced a significant ethical dilemma. What was the situation and what did you do?

Additionally, include a brief personal statement as to why you deserve to receive this scholarship and in what way it will further impact your education.

An essay of 1000 words or less that clearly answers two specific questions:

What modern, living woman do you admire and why? What qualities about her contribute positively to the world of business?

How do you see the landscape of business changing in the next few years in regards to women in business and how would you like to contribute to the advancement of women business leaders in your future profession?

Essay – must be between 300-500 words on the following topic:

There have been many public service campaigns about the dangers of drinking and driving; however, people continue to make the unfortunate decision to drink and get behind the wheel. Write an essay about the reasons why people continue to drink and drive – and what initiatives could be executed to address those reasons.

Submit a photo that you captured which in your eyes, “captures life’s joy” and write a 400-600 word essay on why this photo captures those emotions. Finally, include what capturing life’s joy means to you.

Write an Essay between 700 to 1000 words on the subject “Sewing in the Modern World“, where we’d like you to write about why modern people might come to be interested in sewing and how they might pursue their passion in the modern world.

Simply create essay with 1000+ words in length about couponing, deals and/or personal finance and what you’ve learned about money on your own.
