Annotated Bibliography Borger

Discussion of Prompt:

- 1. Read and **annotate** 5-7 articles on a topic of your choice. At least ½ of your entries need to come from library databases.
- 2. Start each entry with the bibliographic citation: follow MLA/APA format from the Purdue OWL website or use Scribbr. Our guest speaker will show you how to use the auto-cite function in Google Docs too.¹
- 3. Entries that are longer than a single line are reverse-indented. List entries in *alphabetical order by author's last name*.
- 4. Include at least 3-4 significant quotes per entry. Quotes should be key to the argument; don't just pick random quotes.

At this point, you've used and made a number of annotated bibliographies. The format is up to you - but quotes are key (as are all parenthetical citations). The more work you do on your bib, the easier it will be for you to write your paper.

Remember: Try to think beyond one project when conducting research for yourself. You're using this NOW, but it could be beneficial to your future-self later.
